RED WINES

- 5 **Tannat, Catamayor 2003 Uruguay £12.50**
An extremely deep coloured wine with lovely ripe fruit on the nose. This is backed up by the firm tannins which combine very well with the ripe fruit.

- 6 **Primitivo del Salento, Terrale Puglia £13.50**
2002/3 Italy
Deep colour with some mature hints. Lifted dried apricot/prune with spice and cinnamon notes. Palate starts deep and persists but soft and long with apricots and prunes following.
- 7 **Cabernet/Shiraz, Moondah Brook 2003 £16.75**
Western Australia
The fruit for this wine was harvested from vines of up to twenty five years of age. The result is a soft red, with dark berry and herby characters.
- 8 **Rioja Crianza, Marqués de Cáceres 2002 £16.75**
Rioja
Fresh, fruity bouquet of soft red fruits with a touch of vanilla and spice. Pleasant fullness in the mouth with well-defined but silky tannins and a fleshy finish.
- 9 **Pinot Noir, Waipara, Hanmer Junction £21.50**
2001 New Zealand
Lighter style with different components that will gain complexity with time. Maturation was, in French oak barriques to produce a distinctive ripe berry fruit character enhanced with spicy oak.
- 10 **Wild Boar Red, Vin de Pays du Var 2002 £17.20**
Provence, France
A lively, supple red, packed with ripe berry-fruit characters. 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Carignan.
- 11 **Pinotage, De Waal Estate 2002 £20.00**
Stellenbosch
"Ripe, soft plum and cherry flavours and a hint of chocolate" comments Danie de Waal, who was awarded the Diners Club Winemaker of the Year Award for his Pinotage
- 12 **Zinfandel, Blackstone 2002 £15.50**
California U.S.A.
Rich in purple plum, smokey oak and vanilla aromas. The wine has intense flavours of fresh and stewed plums, with distinctive spice and black pepper overtones.

WHITE WINES

- 13 **Chardonnay, Vin de Pays de l'Ardeche, £13.50**
Louis Latour 2004 France
A fresh pale lemon colour, with a full round fresh fruity bouquet of citrus and lemon fruits. The palate is light and elegant with balancing acidity and a clean finish.

- 14 **Sauvignon Blanc, Admiralty House 2005 £13.50**
Stellenbosch
Typically cool climate Sauvignon with a fresh, crisp fruit structure in a wide spectrum of flavours and aromas ranging from ripe passion and kiwi fruit to fig and fresh cut grass, superbly balanced with a zingy, mineral acidity.

- 15 **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur lie, £14.50**
Chateau Salmoniere 2004 Loire
A crisp refreshing wine with an attractive green apple nose and layered fruit on the palate. Full of complex, layered fruit and mineral characters.
- 16 **The Jibe, Sauvignon Blanc 2005 £16.50**
Marlborough
Youthful, refreshing fruit flavours overlay a structure of fresh, racy acidity. Nectarine and passion fruit flavours are layered with ripe herbal characters creating wonderful mouthfeel.
- 17 **Marsanne/Viognier, Vignoble du Sud, £12.00**
Vin de Pays d'Oc, Foncalieu France 2004/5
From a blend of 70% Marsanne and 30% Viognier, to produce a medium dry wine with an intense fruity nose and ripe exotic fruit aromas. The palate lingers with a wonderful balance between fruit and freshness.
- 18 **Lamezia Greco, Statti 2005 £15.25**
Italy
A superb Greco which was one of the star wines tasted at Vinitaly. Dry, yet fragranced and appealing.
- 19 **Chardonnay, Private Collection (unfiltered), £19.50**
Torreón de Parades 1999/00 Rengo Valley
Made from individually selected grapes, this is a premium Chilean Chardonnay from an exceptional vintage: ripe, round and packed with fruit.

- 20 **Sancerre, Paul Thomas, Chavignol 2004** £23.500
Loire
 From vineyards on the prime site of the hill opposite the village of Chavignol, vinified under the watchful eye of Arnaud Bourgeois, this is quintessential Sancerre. Superb.
- 21 **Chablis, 1er Cru, Côte de Lechet,** £28.00
Domaine Daniel-Etienne Defaix 1998
 A premier Cru made by the oldest firm in Chablis. This wine exhibits all the hallmarks of this classic region: a pale colour flecked with green, a racy, lemony nose with a steely, elegant crisp apple acidity. A natural accompaniment to seafood.

SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

- 1 **Pinot Grigio Spumante, Ca'lungchetta NV** £15.00
Italy
 Made from 100% Pinot Grigio grapes, this refreshing wine has delicate fruity notes and a medium dry finish. Wonderful sparkling example of one of the most popular grape varieties at the moment.
- 2 **Perrier Jouët Brut NV** £33.00
France
 A light, elegant Champagne with lots of fruit on the palate.

ROSÉ

- 3 **Pinot Grigio Blush, IGT,** £15.75
Terre degli Osci, Molise Region, 2004
 The grape must is left on the skins for about twelve hours to give the wine its characteristic pale rose colour. The result is an attractive wine, dry, soft and well-balanced.
- 4 **Sancerre Rosé, Paul Thomas, Chavignol** £24.00
2004 Loire
 Attractive pale pink wine with a floral and fruity nose. This light and classy wine displays the delicious fruit character of the Pinot Noir grape and has a long and elegant finish.
